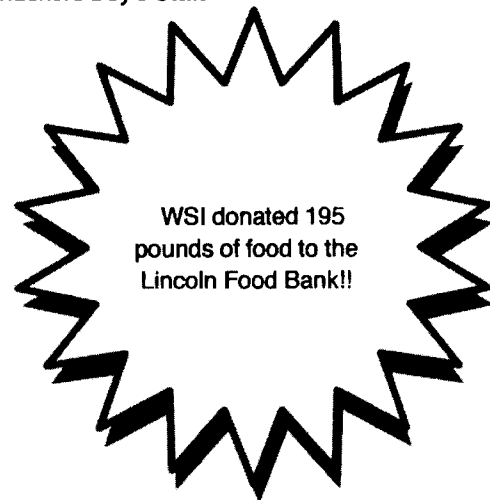

To become a member of the Men's Breakfast Club, you must be a member of the Welfare Society and retired

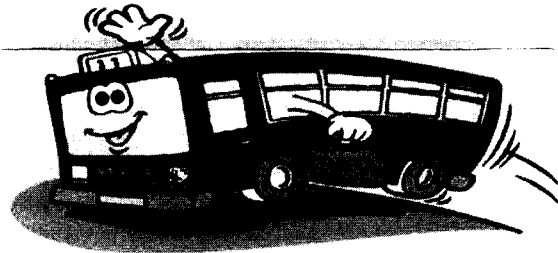
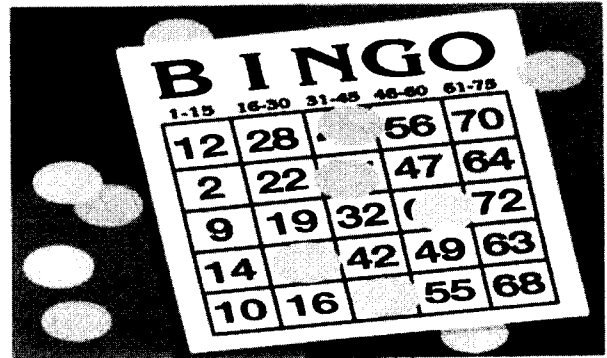
