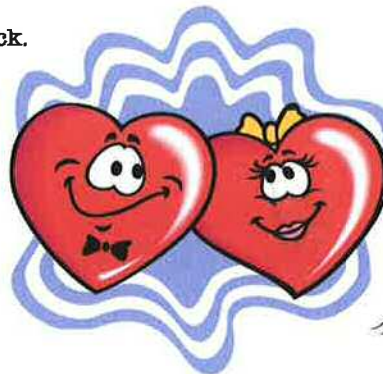

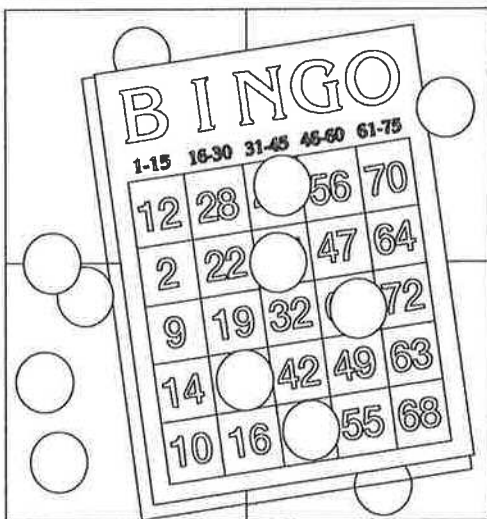

As a man, I don't scare easily but she scared me so much I dropped my electric shaver, which knocked the donut out of my other hand.

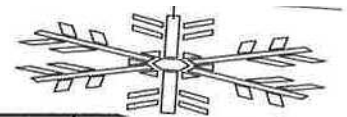
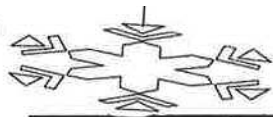
